

Central Arkansas Christian Schools Secondary Campus Before and After School Policies and Guidelines

In order to provide for the appropriate supervision of students, we have made changes to our before and after school guidelines and policies for the upcoming school year. Our goal is to provide economical extended care for families who need this service, while ensuring the safety and well-being of all of our students. As in past years, all students who remain on campus after 4:00 p.m. must report to After-School Care. This year there will be a nominal charge for this service.

Before School

- 1) ***Optional*** before school care is available from 7:00 to 7:45 a.m. for middle school (6th-8th grade) students in the Freeman Science Center. Extended Care options, rates, and enrollment contract are available under the secondary campus student handbook and policies page on the school website.
- 2) The atrium is open each day at 7:00 a.m. A teacher is on duty from 7:30-7:55 a.m. The school does not provide direct supervision for students who arrive before 7:30 a.m. who are not enrolled in extended care and at their assigned location. Administrative staff are on campus at this time.
- 3) The main building and Diles Activity Center open at 7:30 a.m. when faculty and staff report.
- 4) Classrooms open at 7:45 a.m.
- 5) Teachers are available by appointment beginning at 7:30 a.m.

After School

- 1) The school day ends at 3:30 p.m.
- 2) Students in 7th-12th grade may be picked-up in front of the atrium and main building.
- 3) Sixth grade students may be picked-up in front of the Freeman Science Center until 3:45 p.m. Sixth graders remaining at school after 3:45 will be taken to Extended Care or escorted to the appropriate bus for transport to an elementary campus. Sixth grade students who are picked up before 4:00 p.m. are not charged for After-School Care and do not need to select an after-school plan.
- 4) The main building and Diles Activity Center remain open until 4:00 p.m. Students in 7th through 12th grade may meet with teachers or visit their lockers from 3:30 to 4:00 p.m.
- 5) All students who remain on campus after 4:00 p.m. and who are not participating in an after-school activity under the direct supervision of a faculty member, must report to Extended Care in the Freeman Science Center.
- 6) Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, there will be a nominal charge for this service. Extended Care options, rates, and enrollment contract are available on the school website.
